

LEADING THE NEXT GENERATION

The Auburn Wesley Foundation has a long history of fostering ministry leaders for the Church - in both clergy and lay leadership roles. More than 80 Auburn Wesley alumni are recorded as entering full-time ministry service and eight are currently in seminary. One way of cultivating that call has been the intern program. Interns are graduates who choose to remain in Auburn for a year and serve on staff with the Auburn Wesley Foundation, while receiving a modest salary. The goal of their internship is to support student leaders, serve Christ, and continue to explore what the next steps beyond Wesley might be.

Along with the hands-on work of ministering alongside our student leaders, we are continuing to develop the intern experience to include opportunities for leadership development and vocational exploration. Interns participate in activities such as conferences, mentoring conversations with other Christian leaders, and learning together through study and prayer.
